## Team Outdoors TV Comes to Cabo



A few months back we were contacted by the producer of Team Outdoors TV, Billy Brenton, about the possibility of filming in Cabo. The show, which is sponsored by Lowrance and shown on the Sportsmans Channel, primarily focuses on freshwater fishing in North America. Previous shows have included Walleye fishing in North Dakota, Salmon fishing on Lake Michigan, Lake Trout and Northern Pike fishing from Canada and even ice fishing for Trout in Wyoming. But this time Billy had something else in mind.

Billy wanted to show his viewers a whole new genre of fishing, and personally I think he wanted to warm up a bit. So, after working out a few particulars Team Outdoors made the trip south to Baja California to fish in Cabo and to experience all that our waters have to offer.

The guys decided on the 12th, 13th, and 14th of December for their fishing adventure and an adventure it was. Billy brought along Duane Hons, co-founder of Western Walleye Magazine, as well as Doug O'Hara and Tony Guthrie from Lowrance. The guys fished on El Nuevo Redrum, the 33' Bertram, with Captain Pablo as their guide for the 3 days of fishing.

December 12th was day one of their Baja experience so we figured we would try to give them each a fight like they had never had before, a Marlin fight. Capt. Pablo told us the Golden Gate banks had been very productive lately, so we turned right out of the marina and headed north. To say these guys had some phenomenal fishing would be an understatement. Arriving at Golden Gate around 8am the boat had steady hookups until 1pm when they decided to call it a day. 4 Marlin and 6 Dorado later the guys were spent. The guys could not believe the fight of the Marlin and even the Dorado,
